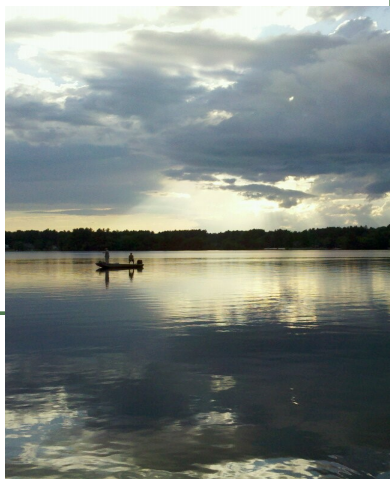

LLCA BOATING SAFETY RULES

- 1) All boats exceeding 6 mph must travel counter clockwise on the lake.
- 2) Travel between the red buoys at the channel. Observe NO WAKE ZONE through the second shallow buoys. Do not exceed 6 mph.
- 3) Do not begin skiing, tubing, wake boarding or revving motor boat engine to plane speed within 150 feet from shore.
- 4) Observe flood postings; make no waves that dislodge docks.
- 5) Do not exceed 6 mph at the Camp Atwater passage. Stay outside beach buoys.
- 6) Do not exceed 6 mph after sunset.
- 7) Carry registration and PFD vests at all times. Have an observer when towing.
- 8) Clean bottom of craft and prop of any weeds before and after launch.
